

BOTANICAL NAMEFicus benghalensis

ENGLISH NAME- Indian banyan, Banyan fig

HINDI NAME- Peeple

FAMILY- Moraceae

DESCEIPTION:

- Ficus benghalensis, is a evergreen fast growing tree, that can reach a height up to 30 meter.
- It produces propagating roots which grow downwards as aerial roots on the branches that grow downward like linas.
- ❖ The figs produced by the tree are eaten by birds as the Indian myna. Fig seeds that pass through the digestive system of birds are more likely to germinate and sprout earlier.

USES:

- ❖ For diarrhea and dysentery The leaf buds of the banyan tree are beneficial in treating choronic diarrhea and dysentery.
- ❖ For female sterility- tender roots of the tree are considered beneficial in treating female sterility.
- ❖ For leucorrhea doughing with the lukeworm decoction of banayan bark to keep the vaginal tract tissues healthy.
