

BOTANICAL NAME- Delonix regia

ENGLISH NAME – flamboyant peacock

HINDI NAME – Gulmohur

FAMILY - Caesalpiniaceae

## **DESCRIPTION:**

- Middle sized tree, deciduous.
- Bark light brown; not rough.
- ❖ Leaves twice feathered with 10-20 pairs of side- stalked; each one with up to 30 pairs of small, blunt leaflets.
- ❖ Flowers in loose clusters; 5 petal − 4 scarlet, one white splashed with scarlet and yellow.
- Fruit a flat pod, dark, up to 60 cm long.

## **USES:**

- Gulmohar achieves its limelight from April to June. It is widely cultivated for ornamental purposes, seen mostly on the sides of roads and pavements giving off its delicate aroma and cooling the eyes with its orange-red colours, not to forget its excellent shade.
