

BOTANICAL NAME- Aegle marmelos

ENGLISH NAME- golden apple, stone apple
HINDI NAME- Bael
FAMILY- Rutaceae

DESCRIPTION:

- Middle sized tree deciduous.
- Spines strong, straight, solitary, about 2.5 cm long.
- ❖ Bark pale somewhat corky, with shallow furrows.
- Leaves compound with 3 leaflets, the central one largest with a long stalk; side leaflets on very short stalks; margin have minute, rounded teeth.
- Flowers fragrant, about 3 cm wide, with 4 or 5 thick petals bent backwards; numerous spreading stamens.
- Fruit large, globose, with a hard shell; orange, glutinous pulp inside.

USES:

- The fruit, leaf and root bark have proven tonic, antibiotic, digestive and antiinflammatory properties.
- ❖ It is used I the treatment of snakebite, dysentery and other diseases of the digestive system, heart, eye, skin and liver.
- Its pale yellowish wood lacks many distinct heartwood but its strong and hard and use to make pestles for oil mills, tool handles.
- ❖ Bael is regarded as a scared tree as its leaves are essential ingredient in votive offering to shiva.
