ENGLISH NAME- Almond
HINDI NAME- Badam
FAMILY- Rosaceae

DESCRIPTION:

- Almond is a deciduous tree ranging in height from four to ten metres with a trunk diameter of up to 30 centimetres.
- Bark blackish, rough
- Leaves narrow, finely toothed; base tapering, pointy tip
- ❖ Flowers pink or pale rose; fading to white; often in pairs, appearing before the leaves; 5 petals with pink stamen.
- Fruit grey green, with a downy coat; fleshy leathery; a hard pitted stone at the centre, containing the almond.

USES:

- Enhances the digestive system's health.
- Works as a supplement to meet nutritional needs during pregnancy.
- Enhances the workings of the brain.
- Helps in moisturising the skin.
- Reduces blood levels of cholesterol.
- Helps maintain a healthy heart.
- Maintains a normal level of blood pressure.
