The physical and mental health related to the consequences of Covid-19 infection has made the educational scenario drastically affected. When there was a condition of lockdown and the college got closed, the students in their family and society were losing human lives and were fighting for lives and then the after Covid effects has put the education on the back front. Many young minds then came forward to do Social work and to opt for alternative measures with the teaching staff during pandemic period and to cope with its after effects. Many mitigation measures were adopted by the college to bring the education to its normal position to support the students and staff and to bring the anxiety level down. Students and staff worked together as a task force to bring the life back on track.

(A) Medical Service -

2. Online data management / retrieval of vaccination status of Students and their family members. -

With the help of Tutor - Guardian scheme of the college, all the students of the college were contacted by the faculty members to make them aware about the benefits of vaccination. They were also encouraged to aware in their family and in the society. With the help of TG groups, students were encouraged to send their vaccination certificates to their respecting Tutor Guardian. They were also motivated to send the vaccine status of their parents. This way a data of vaccinated students was generated in the TG groups.

3. Program of UNICEF -

The United Nations International Children's Emergency fund provides humanitarian and developmental aid to children worldwide. It works to assure equality for those who are discriminated against, girls/women in particular. UNICEF has oganized a program related to "Smart

Hand wash- Hackathon", an online drawing competition for college student held on 16/10/2021.

(B) Social Service -

1. Roko-Toko Campaign -

Students have organized a nukkad - natak (street - play) cum campaign to spread awareness among students and society by dramatically casting Yamraj and Chitragupt.

Yamraj is the Hindu God of death, responsible for the punishment of sinners in his abode, 'Yam Lok'. He is accompanied by Chitragupt, another deity associated with death.

In modern culture these are depicted in various safety campaigns, to warn against the dangers. Two Students of the college have dresses up as Yamraj and Chitragupt and went in nearby market places to aware the society against the safety measures required to fight against Covid-19.

The moto behind this was to showcase the encounter of careless society with the God of Death. This casting has spread an important message to use mask, to wear it properly, importance of hand washing, use of sanitizer and importance of maintaining social distancing. This program was coordinated by NSS on from 01-12-2020 to 06-12-2020.

2. COVID - Warriors -

To contain the spread of virus, when the life was stand-still, college students played their rote by working with health-care workers and served the society. Putting their own lives at risk with selfless determination for the sake of saving lives, the college students served as heroes in these challenging times. Students came forward to educate people to follow pandemic protocol and safety measures. This COVID awareness programs included spreading awareness by posters during COVID time, mask distribution and duty of students at Call Centre (May - June 2020 during Covid time) by NCC.

3. A program based on "Kya Khoya - Kya Paya during COVID lockdown" - A group discussion was held on 17.09.2020 on Zoom platform by the students of EBSEB club.

4. Social Service at Railway Station -

NSS volunteers and some other students have distributed marks, sanitizers and food to the passenger of "Shramik Special Train" (Train for Laborers), at Bhopal railway station. Students have also carried out thermal screening of passenger and helped in awareness of Covid-19 during year 2020 lockdown.

5. Cleanliness Rally -

On 30.12.2019 Cleanliness rally and Nukkad Natak was organized from Press Complex, M.P. Nagar to Milan Namkeen corner, a distance of 3-4 kilometers, zone – I, MP Nagar, Bhopal to spread awareness for cleanliness. Cleanliness week (Swatchhata Pakhwada) program was organized.

- 6. Students have visited orphanage and to the shelter homes of poor and needy, through the EK Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Club of the college and distributed food items and spread awareness for prevention measures of Covid -19.
- 7. Students and Staff members have donated grains (Ann daan maha daan) in "Prerna Seva trust" NGO at Hamidia hospital, Bhopal on 20.12.2019 and the staff members have also donated stationary, mask and other items in village.
- 8. Oxygen Concentrators were donated to the hospital of Sehore district by the Commerce department of the college.
- 9. Phenyl, Sanizer & masks were prepared in the College & donated in society.
- 10. NOGA, the alumni Association of the college has donated masks in the society.
- 11. Charitable work was done by donating exam fee of the students by the staff members and NOGA members.
- 12. The housekeeping staff of the college was honored by the NSS unit, for offering their services during and after pandemic period. This initiative was meant to motivate them and to put the sentiments of college administration for their special services during difficult situations and acknowledged their work.

(C) Academic Front -

1. Online Classes -

Remote teaching-learning process was carried out during Covid-19, as the pandemic situation has disrupted the education and affected the college students, the college started online classes as an emergency response to save them from sad back on education. The teachers have shared the time table and contacted students on their mobile phones. They have used various platforms to connect with their class like Google meet, Zoom, MS Teams etc. This way students got the benefits of teaching at their door steps.

As a negative aspect related to it is that not all students found it feasible to connect from their villages. But this ecosystem was found effective to cope up in these situations.

2. Online exams -

The autonomous cell of the college has conducted online exams (semester/ main exam/ CCE) during pandemic period in the time of Lock down imposed by district administration.

3. Virtual industrial visits -

Due to pandemic and during lockdown, students have made the most use of online platforms for the academic and co-curricular activities. As during this period the virtual reality came at the forefront. So in place of conventional industrial visits, college has organized virtual visits for students as a value added Education mean. These types of visits have bridged between theory and practical in case of virtual accessibility to the place.

4. Virtual lab visits -

During pandemic times, students have provided a learning experience through remote-access to labs. This would have helped them in learning basic concepts through remote experiments and instruments. This served as a tool for learning including additional web links for such purpose and video - lectures.

7. Online project work -

When students have returned to their native places/villages, left the hostels and returned homes, it was found difficult to make them complete their project work. In such situation during pandemic, the college allowed them to complete their projects in a blended manner. Those who could access any places for their project, were allowed to complete it there and with video calls using IT technology were stayed connected with their concerning teacher guide and were gone through the viva for projects. They got connected online for oral exams, sent their reports through e-mails and shared the score cards (marks as external) also.
