DESCEIPTION :

- ❖ Plumeria flowers are highly fragrant , yet yield no necter.
- ❖ The scent is strongest in night , to lure sphinx moths into pollinating them by transferring pollen from flower to flower in their fruitless search for necter.
- ❖ The trunk and branches of the Plumeria species have a milky latex sap that, like many other Apocynaceae, contains poisonous compounds that irritate the eyes and skin
