TENURE OF THE COUNCIL -

The tenure of the members of the council shall be two years.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND -

College tries to get financial assistance for Faculty Development Fund from World Bank, RUSA, UGC, Department of higher Education govt. of M.P. and Janbhagidari Samiti.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- It is the responsibility of the Faculty Development Council (FDC) of the college to organize training/input sessions for the entire faculty by eminent scholars from repute national/ international institutions. There shall be a minimum of two such programmes in an academic year.
- Professional qualification is always a benchmark of quality. Hence all the faculty members shall have PhD, either during the time of appointment or within five years of the joining.FDC should motivate the faculty to achieve PhD degree.
- FDC is responsible for development and design of SWAYAM (Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds) Platform for hosting Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) in terms of MHRD's OM No.8-26/2014 dated 21st March, 2016 by blending academics with technology.

- FDC shall be responsible for creating self-paced learning in various areas, like, Yoga, GST, Economic Survey, Skill development and Curriculum bases Training Programs / Workshops (Science, Humanities & Social Sciences, Commerce, Management, and other Inter-Disciplinary Areas)
- Responsible for developing and designing soft skill enhancement programmes such as -
